### **The Tim Hawkes Trophy for Aggregate Athletics**

*Dr Tim Hawkes was the Principal of St Leonard's College from 1990 to 1997, at a time when St Leonard's was very strong in athletics. Dr Hawkes was one of the foundation Heads of the ACS, and was its first Chairman.*

### **The Brian McLean Trophy for Girls Aggregate Athletics**

*Brian McLean was the original Sportsmaster of Eltham College and recently retired as Head of Senior School.*

### **The Downing Family Trophy for Boys Aggregate Athletics**

*John Kennedy is one of the founding Principals of the Association.*
